#### (i) INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 This report provides an update on the growth trends for the telecom services for the period **Oct-Dec 2004.** It presents a broad perspective on the Telecom Services to serve as a reference document for various stakeholders, research agencies and analysts as an update over the previous reports, which pertained to financial year 2002-2003, four quarters of financial year 2003-2004 and two quarters of current financial year. Due to the Unified Access Service Regime, the details under mobile services combine both GSM & CDMA. The Fixed Service details also include WLL (F) and Village Public Telephones (VPT). The summary of the growth pattern of Fixed, Mobile and Internet services in form of 'Quarterly results at a Glance' is given at the beginning of this compilation.
- 1.2 The information for this report has been collected from various telecom operators and service providers. TRAI collects performance-oriented data from various service providers on a quarterly basis to monitor the growth trend in the sector and to decide upon pro-active and suo motto measures to fuel the growth of the telecom services in the country. The data provided in this report is purely provisional and subject to change. TRAI regularly conducts review of its data collection programme to ensure that its processes remains appropriate/relevant in the rapidly growing telecom sector and are consistent with changing regulatory framework.

#### PERFORMANCE OF FIXED SERVICES

Subscribers Base crosses 44 million

#### 1.1 SUBSCRIBERS BASE: -

1.1.1 As on 31st December 2004, the fixed lines were provided by 5 licensed private operators in addition to incumbents BSNL and MTNL. During the quarter M/s Tata Teleservices has started their services in Bihar, Orissa and Rajasthan circles. List of Fixed Service provider's along with their area of operation is given in Table 1:






#### 1.1.2 Market Share of DELs

As on 31st December 2004, the total subscriber base of Fixed lines including WLL (F) stood at 44.9 million. The incumbents BSNL and MTNL have 81% and 9% market share respectively in the subscriber base, while all the five private operators have 10% share. In the current quarter the share of private operators has increased by 2% and the share of BSNL has declined by 2% respectively, whereas the share of MTNL remains the same.











#### 1.1.3 Subscriber Base of Fixed & WLL(F) for last five quarters

The subscriber base of the Fixed service sector for last five quarters is depicted in the bar chart below:










#### 1.1.4 Growth of DELs

The Fixed Service sector has registered a growth of 10,03,761 lines during the Quarter from 1<sup>st</sup> October 2004 to 31<sup>st</sup> December 2004. The actual number of DELs has increased from 4,38,68,346 as on 30<sup>th</sup> Sept 2004 to 4,48,72,107 as on 31<sup>st</sup> December 2004. The overall percentage of growth in subscriber base during the Quarter is 2.24%.

#### Average percentage growth rate of Fixed Wireline and WLL(F) Subscribers








#### 1.2 Other Performance Indicators: -

#### 1.2.1 Public Call Offices:

During the current quarter 2,65,234 new PCOs have been added. Total number of PCOs in the country as on 31st December 2004 is 25,31,312. The share of BSNL is 17,84,643 (70%) of the total PCOs. The share of MTNL and other private operators is 2,71,709 (11 %) and 4,74,960(19%) respectively.



#### 1.2.2 Village Public Telephones:

There are 6,07,491 villages in India. During the quarter ending 30<sup>th</sup> Sept 2004 there were 5,24,086 VPTs in the country whereas by the end of this quarter, the total number of VPTs has increased to 5,37,238. Thus 13,152 VPTs have been added during the current quarter. The total number of villages left uncovered, as on 31st December 2004 are 70,253. BSNL has added 13,182 VPTs during the quarter whereas there was a decrease of 28 VPTs of HFCL and 2 VPTs of TTL (AP) respectively during this quarter.

Circle-wise details of Cellular, Fixed & Unified Access Service providers at the end of the quarter are given at Annex 2.1. All the service areas of the country have mobile operators ranging from 3 to 7.

#### 2.1 Growth of Subscribers Base: -

#### 2.1.1 **Subscribers Base**

The Mobile (GSM and CDMA) Industry has crossed the 48 million subscribers mark (GSM 37.4 million & CDMA 10.6 million) at the close of quarter ending 31<sup>st</sup> December 2004.

#### 2.1.2 Addition in Subscribers Base

The mobile subscriber's base stood at 48 million for the quarter ending December 2004 as against 43 million for the quarter ending September 2004. It added around 5 million subscribers in this quarter.

#### 2.1.3 Growth Rate

The growth for this quarter is 11.67% as against 13.87% for the quarter ending September 2004. M/s Reliance remains the largest mobile operator followed by M/s Bharti and M/s BSNL.

#### 2.1.4 Company wise Market Share:

a) The Subscriber Base of different Mobile operators is given in Table 2.1. The top five Mobile operators on the basis of market share are as under: -

b) Distribution of Subscriber Base and market share of Mobile (GSM) service as on December 2004 among Metros, Circles A to C is given in Table 2.3.

#### 2.1.5 Change in Market Structure

M/s Reliance and M/s Bharti have acquired licence in all 23-service areas for offering mobile services. M/s BSNL is offering services in all 21-service areas. M/s Tata Teleservices and M/s Hutch are licensed in 20 and 13 service areas respectively.

M/s Reliance is offering services in all its service areas except J&K. M/s Bharti Cellular Ltd has started its services in UP (W), West Bengal and Orissa now they are providing services in 20 circles. M/s Bharti is yet to start its services in Bihar, Assam and North-East circles. M/s Hutchison Telecom has started its services in West Bengal and now they providing services in 13 circles. M/s Tata Teleservices started its services in Rajasthan, Bihar and Orissa circles and now they are providing services in 11 circles. The name of M/s Hexacom India Limited is changed to M/s Bharti Hexacom Limited with effect from Dec. 2, 2004.

In this quarter, the subscriber's base of mobile services has crossed the subscriber's base of Fixed Network on All India basis.

#### **PART B**

#### 2.2 Mobile [Cellular and WLL (M)] Services Trends: -

#### 2.2.1 Highlights:

- Share of prepaid subscribers in total mobile (GSM) subscriber base is 74% at the end of September 2004.
- Postpaid subscriber base has maintained the trend of faster rate of growth than prepaid subscriber base in Mobile service (GSM). Since March-04 postpaid subscriber base has grown by 32% whereas prepaid subscriber base has grown by 26%.
- All India ARPU for Mobile service (GSM) for the quarter is Rs. 404 showing a decline of 7% from the figure of Rs.436 for the quarter ending Mar-04.
- The ARPU of BSNL/MTNL that has been higher than the ARPU of private operators in the past has become almost equal to that of private CMSPs in Sept-04.
- Difference of ARPU between postpaid and prepaid is narrowing down as a result of availability of low rental postpaid tariff plans in the market. In Sept-04 postpaid ARPU (Rs. 707) has been 2.37 times the prepaid ARPU (Rs. 299) as against 3.36 times of the prepaid ARPU in the quarter ending Mar-04.
- MOU per subscriber per month for Mobile service (GSM) for September 2004 is 302 as compared with the figure of 322 in March 2004, recording a decline of about 7%.
- As per the data provided by the mobile service providers (GSM), on an all India average, a subscriber sends about 30 SMS per month.
- The ratio of incoming outgoing calls in Mobile (GSM) traffic is 64:36 during this period.
- Overall proportion of roaming revenue to the total revenue for GSM operators is 12.08%.

#### 2.2.2 **ARPU – Cellular Service**

The all India blended ARPU per month for Mobile Service (GSM) for the quarter has declined by 7% from Rs. 436 in the quarter ending Mar-04 to 404 in the quarter ending Sept-04. The lowest blended ARPU is in Circle B (Rs. 355) and the highest is in Metro (Rs. 476). Difference of ARPU between postpaid and prepaid is narrowing down as a result of availability of low rental postpaid tariff plans in the market. In

Sept-04 postpaid ARPU (707) has been 2.37 times the prepaid ARPU (299) as against 3.36 times difference in the quarter ending Mar-04. Such difference between postpaid ARPU and prepaid ARPU is maximum in Metro.

#### 2.2.3 Composition of Revenue of Cellular Service Providers

### 2.2.4 Usage Pattern in Cellular Service

Minutes of Use (MOU) per subscriber per month for Mobile service (GSM) during the quarter ending September 2004 was 302 as against 322 during the quarter ending March 2004, thereby showing a decline of 6%. The incoming-outgoing call ratio is 64:36. The highest MOU per subscriber is observed in Circle A at 326 and the lowest in Circle B at 249. In the postpaid platform, highest MOUs per subscriber is in Metros at 656. The highest MOU per subscriber in prepaid segment is in Circle C at 257. (Annex 2.2).

#### 2.2.5 Revenue per Minute (RPM) - Cellular Service

There has not been any major change in the RPM since March 2004. RPM for the quarter ending March 2004 was 1.35.



#### 2.2.6 Minimum Effective Charge:

From this issue of "Telecom Performance Indicators", the series in respect of Trends in mobile tariffs has undergone change to reflect the actual payout by an average user with a total outgoing MOU [local] of 250 per month. This series is different from the earlier one, in more than one ways. Post- CPP period has been considered for analysis in the new series. The assumptions made are as below:

- 1. Total outgoing traffic has been distributed between fixed and mobile based on the market share of the networks prevailed at the end of the respective quarter upto Sep-04. From Dec-04 onwards, the traffic information furnished by the Mobile (GSM) operators as a part of quarterly revenue report have been used.
- 2. Charges payable by the subscriber on account of rental, local call charges, and CLIP are included. Free call allowance has also been considered.
- 3. Service tax and other levies are excluded.
- 4. Average holding time is taken as 1 minute
- 5. 30% of the usage has been attributed to on-net calls, wherever concessional rates for such calls are provided
- 6. Charges have been calculated for outgoing usage only since incoming calls are free due to CPP w.e.f. 1.5.03



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#### **Chapter Three**

#### **Performance of Internet Services**

Subscribers base inches towards 5.5 million mark.
Broadband appears

#### 3.1 Service Providers & Subscribers Base: -

For the quarter ending December 2004, 180 Internet Service Providers were operational. Bharat Sanchar Nigam Ltd (BSNL) has retained its top position and reported a subscriber base of 16.79 Lakhs against 14.94 Lakhs during the last quarter. Mahanagar Telephone Nigam Limited (MTNL) moved up from third position to second position with a subscriber's base of 9.49 Lakhs against 9.15 Lakhs subscribers during the last quarter. Videsh Sanchar Nigam Limited has slipped to third position with a subscriber base of 9.35 Lakhs against 9.85 Lakhs. M/s Sify Ltd. has retained its fourth position during the quarter with a subscriber base of 7.72 Lakhs. Data Infosys reported a subscriber base of 2.48 Lakhs and remained at fifth place during the quarter ending 31st December 2004. (ref Table 3.1).

The reported subscriber base has touched 54.50 lakhs as on quarter ending 31st December, 2004 as compared to 51.46 lakhs during the preceding quarter registering an increase of 6 % during the quarter.

#### 3.2 Internet Telephony: -

The Internet Telephony was thrown open for Internet service provider's w.e.f. 1<sup>st</sup> April'02. DOT has given permission to 121 ISPs to offer Internet Telephony services as on December 2004, and as per the report submitted to TRAI, 51 ISPs have started Internet Telephony services, the list of which is enclosed at Annex 3.2. Total minutes of the usage for Internet Telephony during the quarter were 43 million, as compared to 36 million for the last quarter


#### 3.3 Market Share: -

The reported subscriber base has touched 54.50 lakhs as on quarter ending 31st December, 2004 as compared to 51.46 lakhs during the preceding quarter registering an increase of 6 % during the quarter.



Among PSU owned ISPs; M/s BSNL has reported a subscriber's base of 16.79 Lakhs during the quarter ending 31st December, 2004 as against 14.94 Lakhs during the previous quarter registering an increase of 12.35 %. M/s MTNL have reported a subscriber base of 9.49 Lakhs against the subscriber base of 9.15 Lakhs reported during the previous quarter, registering an increase of 3.73 %.



#### **Growth Trends**



#### 3.4 Leased Lines Connectivity: -

The numbers of Leased Lines connections reached 12,195 during the quarter as compared to 10,744 during last quarter.

#### 3.5 Cyber Cafes/Community Internet Centres (CIC): -

There existed 9216 Cyber Cafes during the quarter ending December 2004, out of which 8304 have been franchised by the ISPs and 912 are non-franchised.

#### 3.6 High Speed Internet Connectivity: -

The number of subscribers accessing Internet through "Always On high speed" connection (less than 256 kbps) has reached 6.54 Lakhs, thus showing a growth of 108 % over previous quarter.

#### 3.7 Broadband Connectivity (>=256 Kbps)

The number of Broadband subscribers with a download speed of 256 kbps or more, as reported by ISPs, is 46,638 at the end of 31<sup>st</sup> December 2004.

#### 3.8 Minutes of use per subscriber: -

As reported by 39 ISPs the average minutes of use per subscriber/ month is approximately 275 minutes.

#### 3.9 Average Revenue Per User (ARPU) for ISPs: -

A total of approx. Rs 255 crores revenue has been reported during the quarter. The average revenue per user (ARPU) per month for Internet usage was of the order of Rs 167.

#### 3.10 International connectivity: -

The bandwidth owned by various IGSP for their ISP operations and Leased lines is reported to be 6.3 GB for downlinking and 6 GB for uplinking.

#### **Chapter Four**

#### **Performance of Other Value Added Services**

Growth trend continues

#### 4.1 Public Mobile Radio Trunked Service (PMRTS): -

Public Mobile Radio Trunked Service (PMRTS) is being provided by 13 operators.

#### 4.1.1 Performance during the Quarter Ending 31<sup>st</sup> December 2004:

- The subscriber base of PMRTS increased from 25694 in Sept 2004 to 26153 in Dec 2004 registering a marginal growth rate of 1.79%.
- Delhi, Mumbai, Bangalore and Chennai together account for 70% of market share of the total subscribers. Delhi leads the tally with the market share of 8926 subscribers followed by Bangalore and Mumbai with the market share of 6685 and 3618 subscribers respectively.
- Procall Limited leads the tally of subscribers with a subscriber base of 7916 followed by Arvind Mills and QuickCalls India Pvt. Ltd. with a subscriber base of 6581 and 3663 respectively. Arya Offshore Service Pvt. Ltd., Hapag Liyod and The Arvind Mills Ltd. have registered a negative growth rate of 4.72%, 11.08% and 1.70% respectively. India Satcom Ltd. has increased their subscribers base with the highest growth rate of 17.21%.
- Mobilcom India Ltd. has not submitted their report in this quarter.

The subscriber base of service providers of PMRTS is given in Table 4.1.

#### 4.2 VSAT services: -

VSAT services are being provided by 11 VSAT service providers.

#### 4.2.1 Performance during the quarter ending 31<sup>st</sup> December 2004:

- ➤ VSAT services are being provided by 11 VSAT service providers.
- ➤ M/s RPG Satellite Communications Pvt. Ltd. and M/s Essel Shyam have not submitted their reports.
- ➤ In the present quarter, there was an addition of 3950 new subscribers. The total number of subscribers increased from 32271 in Sept 2004 to 36221 in Dec 2004 registering a growth of 12.24% as against the growth rate of 5.37% in quarter ending Sept 2004. HCL Comnet remained the market leader with 12083 VSAT subscribers followed by Hughes Escorts Communications Ltd. (HECL) with 11458,

Bharti BT with 5179 and Comsat Max with 4221 VSAT subscribers respectively.

- ➤ M/s HCL Comnet added the maximum number of new connections 1800 with a percentage growth rate of 17.50%.
- ➤ M/s ITI Limited has not shown any growth in this quarter while, M/s Telstra Vishesh Communication limited and M/s GNFC and M/s HFCL are having the negative growth of 5.93%, 3.85% and 9.86% respectively in this quarter.

The number of subscribers of each service providers from quarter ending December 2003 to September 2004 along with the Market Share in terms of Percentage of Subscribers as on 31<sup>st</sup> December 2004 is given in Table 4.2.

### 4.3 Radio Paging: -

As on date there are 10 service providers with paging service licensees for 61 service areas.

#### 4.3.1 Performance during the Quarter Ending 31<sup>st</sup> December 2004:

- ❖ The total subscriber base decreased from 43320 in Sept, 2004 to 28028 in December 2004 registering a negative growth of 35.30%.
- ❖ The subscriber base of all the service providers except M/s RPG Paging Services Limited decreased in this quarter. M/s RPG Paging Service has retained the same subscribers base in this quarter as was in previous quarter.
- ❖ In the present quarter Netherlands India Communications Ltd. has not submitted their report.
- ❖ M/s Page Point Services India Limited remained the market leader with 17387 subscribers in this quarter.
- ❖ M/s DSS Mobile Communications has decreased from 7580 to 2963, the highest fall in subscribers base in this quarter with a negative growth rate of 60.91%.

The number of subscribers of each service providers from quarter ending June 2004 to December 2004 along with the growth rate in terms of Percentage of Subscribers as on 31.12.2004 is given in Table 4.3.

#### **Chapter Five**

### **Quality of Service (QOS) Performance**

# 5.1 Quality of Service performance of Basic Service Operators for the Quarter Ending December 2004: -

Based on Quality of Service Parameters reported by Basic Service Operators for the quarter ending December 2004, the information on QoS parameters is attached to this report as Annex 5.1.

From perusal of the report (Annex 5.1) following points emerge: -

# (1) Provision of telephone within 7 days for exchange areas declared "On Demand".

40 out of 63 service providers have not met the QoS benchmark for this parameter. The performance of MTNL (Mumbai) and BSNL (all circles) is way below the benchmark of 100%.

M/s Reliance Infocom Limited (all circles) and Tata teleservices (Delhi) have reported 100% promptness for this parameter.

# (2) Fault incidences per month per 100 telephones (should be less than 3 Faults per 100 phones per month)

BSNL and MTNL have not met the stipulated QoS benchmark for this parameter in all their circles.

Among the private operators M/s Reliance Infocom, Bharti, HFCL and Tata Teleservices (AP, GJ, TN, KTK, Chennai) have met the TRAI stipulated benchmark of <3 faults per month per 100 telephone connections.

M/s Shyam Telelink Limited and M/s Tata Teleservices (Delhi, MH, Mumbai) have not met the QoS benchmark of this parameter.

#### (3) Percentage of faults repaired by next working day ( should be >90%)

16 out of 26 circles of BSNL have met the TRAI's QoS benchmark on "Fault Repair by next working day". MTNL (Delhi & Mumbai) has failed to met the specified QoS benchmarks.

All the private operators except Tata Teleservices (AP) have met the QoS stipulated benchmark of >90% for this parameter.

#### (4) Mean Time to repair (MTTR) ( should be <8hrs.)

Only 7 out of 26 circles of BSNL have met the benchmark. MTNL (Delhi & Mumbai) have failed to meet the benchmark.

Among the private service operators only Tata (AP) have not met the QoS benchmark.

#### (5) Grade of Service for junction between local exchanges (should be < 0.002)

The Figure of **Grade of Service** not reported by BSNL. M/s MTNL and all the private operators have met the TRAI stipulated benchmark.

#### (6) Call Completion Rate in local network (should be >65%)

16 out of 26 service areas of BSNL and MTNL (Delhi and Mumbai) have not met the OoS benchmark.

Among the private Operators HFCL (PB), Shyam Telelink (RJ), Bharti (TN) & Reliance (except BR, Raj, HR, OR, UP-E, UP –W, WB) have achieved the desired QoS benchmark.

# (7) Metering and Billing credibility (Not more than 0.1% of bills should be disputed over a billing cycle

Only 4 out of 26 service areas of BSNL namely A & N, NE-I, NE-II and Orissa have not met the overall QOS benchmark on disputed bills. MTNL (Mumbai) has also not met the same.

Among the Private Operators, only TATA (AP, Delhi, MH, KTK and Mumbai), and Bharti (Delhi, KTK, TN & HR) have not met the QoS benchmark of <0.1%.

# (8) Operator assisted Trunk Calls ( Urgent calls should be answered within 1 hr and Ordinary calls within 2 Hrs.)

BSNL, MTNL and all Private Operators have failed to meet the benchmark in all the circles.

# (9) Customer Care: Promptness in attending 95% of customers requests (Benchmarks for Shifts, Closures and providing additional facilities are <3 days, <24 hours and <24hours respectively)

#### (i) Shifts:-

BSNL (Except in PB and Orissa) have failed to meet the requirement on customer care (shift) in all circles. MTNL (Delhi, Mumbai) have also failed to meet the requirement on Customer care.

Among the private operators Shyam Telelink, Rajasthan, Tata (Delhi, MH) and Reliance (all circles) have met the QOS benchmark on Customer Care (Shifts).

#### (ii) Closures:-

As regards 'Closures' these figures are not available for BSNL for all circles. MTNL (Mumbai) has not met the benchmark.

Among the private operators Tata (DL, KTK, Chennai, Mumbai), Bharti (DL, TN,HR) and HFCL have not met the stipulated benchmark.

#### (iii) Additional Facility:-

BSNL has not reported the figure for additional facility. MTNL (Delhi) have failed to meet the QOS benchmark. Tata (AP, MH, Mumbai, KTK), HFCL (PB) and Bharti (Delhi, TN, HR, KTK) have not met the QoS benchmark.

M/s Reliance Infocomm has reported 100% and M/s Shyam Telelink Limited, Rajasthan above 95% promptness in their all circles for attending customer requests regarding **shifts**, **closures and additional facilities**.

#### (10) Percentage of repeat faults (should be <1%)

In case of Repeat faults, BSNL in all circles (except in TN, HP, Uttranchal) & MTNL (Delhi & Mumbai) have failed to meet the QOS benchmark. Among the private Operators M/s Reliance Infocom Limited, Shyam (RAJ) and Tata (Delhi, TN, Chennai) are within TRAI's benchmark limits.

# 5.2 Quality of Service performance of Cellular Mobile Service Providers for quarter ending 31<sup>st</sup> December 2004: -

- a) This report covers all Cellular Mobile Operators, except CDMA service by Reliance. Reliance are yet to submit their report in respect of circles where they have migrated to 10 digit number.
- b) This report covers (i) 8 companies/group of companies having 25 licenses providing service in 5 "A" category circles (ii) 7 companies/group of companies having 29 licenses for providing service in 8 "B" category circles. (iii) Three companies/group of companies having 13 licensees for providing service in 7 "C" category circles and (iv) 8 companies/group of companies having 18 licenses for service in 4 metros. Thus there are 85 licenses covered in this report for 24 service areas.
- c) Hutch UP-W and Bharti (WB, J&K) have submitted their first performance report in this quarter. Thus, the number of service providers who have reported their QoS performance has increased from 82 to 85 in this quarter.

The summary of status of the service providers who have met the benchmarks in this quarter as compared to previous quarter is given in the following table:

# 5.2.1 The analysis of PMR of 85 Cellular licensees in 24 service areas is as under:

- i) From the table, it is observed that there has been an improvement in the performance as compared to the previous quarter.
- ii) No. of faults (per 100 subscribers) for BSNL- Kolkata, BSNL-Assam, BSNL Bihar, TATA Karnataka and Bharti J & K are 2.40%, 2.00%, 2.90%, 3.06 and 2.50% respectively, which is way beyond the stipulated benchmark of TRAI <1%.
- For the parameter "Fault cleared within 24 hrs" the performance of BSNL (KOLKATA) and TATA (AP) are 72.00% and 79.00% respectively, which is way beyond the stipulated benchmark of 100%.
- iv) 23 Operators are not meeting the benchmark of >99.00% for the parameter of "Call Success Rate (CCR)". CCR for BSNL (Kranataka, Tamil Nadu, Kerala, Orissa) is 88.00%, 89.00%, 88.00%, 89.00% respectively, which is much below the benchmark of 99.00%.
- v) All the Service Providers have met the benchmark of the Parameters for "Service Access Delay" and "Call Drop Rate".
- vi) No. of Complaints per 100 bills issued for BSNL (Kolkata & MH), Tata Mumbai and Idea MH are (2.40%, 1.70%), 1.22% and 1.09% respectively, which is way beyond the benchmark of 0.1%.

#### **5.2.2**. Details of Quality of service:

**Detail of performance related to** fault incidence and repair, network performance and billing complaints **are available at Annex 5.2** 

#### 5.3 Quality of Service Performance of Internet Service Providers: -

- 5.3.1 The annex 5.3 indicates the Quality of Service achieved by Top 20 ISPs during the quarter: It is observed that most of the ISPs are able to meet the benchmarks, barring one or two cases.
- 5.3.2 The observations on QOS Benchmarks is as follows:

#### 5.3.2.1 Service Activation Time:

All the ISPs have met the benchmark of 6 hrs. ISPs (Tata Teleservices Maharashtra Ltd., Broadband Pacenet (I) Pvt. Ltd., Hughes) have not provided the data.

#### 5.3.2.2 Time to Access:

ISPs are required to achieve the benchmark 30 sec. All ISPs have met this target in this quarter. Two ISPs Broadband Pacenet (I) Pvt. Ltd and Hughes have not provided the data. MTNL has not provided the data for 3<sup>rd</sup> attempt for Delhi circle, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> attempts for Mumbai circle.

#### 5.3.2.3 Probability of Accessing the ISP Node:

ISPs are required to maintain the parameter of 80% for the first attempt, 90% for the second attempt and 99% for the third attempt. All the ISPs are able to meet this benchmark. MTNL (for both Delhi and Mumbai), Broadband Pacenet (I) Pvt. Ltd. and Hughes have not provided us the data.

#### 5.3.2.4 ISP Node unavailability:

ISP Nodes unavailability should not exceed 30 minutes in a month. All ISPs are able to achieve this benchmark but MTNL, Broadband Pacenet (I) Pvt. Ltd. and Hughes have not provided us the data.

#### 5.3.2.5 Grade of Service:

ISPs are required to maintain the Grade of Service on the link connecting PSTN node to the ISP node as 1 in 100. Two ISPs (VSNL and BG Broadband India Pvt. Ltd.) has informed that the information regarding the above

mentioned benchmark can not be provided as the BSO has not given the information to them, WWW Communications has not provided the data as per the prescribed format. Broadband Pacenet (I) Pvt. Ltd. and Hughes have not provided the data.

#### 5.3.2.6 Mean Time to Restore (MTTR):

As per clause 1.9 schedule 'C' of ISP license, ISPs are required to rectify 90% of faults resulting due to subscriber complaints within 24 hours and 99% within three days.

All the ISPs have been rectifying the fault within stipulated period of three days.







#### **Growth Rate Trends**







# **Growth Rate of PMRTS subscribers**




