Respected Sir,

The concept of IUC is totally flawed in the context of current scenario. In view of different costing for each type of technology, it would be suitable that costs and benefits of a particular technology are shared among users of that technology only. Therefore TRAI should create a structure where all costs of telecom networks are recovered from its own subscribers rather than cross-subsidization by a variety of technologies. It will also reduce regulatory intervention and allow each technology to compete with other technologies on its own merits.

Since as per TRAI estimates, older telecom technologies are going to be around for a while it is better that cross subsidization across technologies and network be dispensed right away and each technology be permitted to compete on its own merits.
