Below are some comments from Nokia side, with regard to recent published consulting paper for "Infrastructure sharing in broadcasting TV distribution sector"

- The paper seems a bit restrictive in terms of technology – it should have been written technology agnostic – would have been more future safe.
- Example – for delivery, only HFC is listed - what would it mean in case of a distributed CCAP with some TV signals delivered over CDN to the vCCAP ? Would CDN be sharable ?
- Example – CAS is mentioned, but what about the future trend towards DRM ?
- Finally does the suggested model in paper allows a "white label" business model ? Eg. An operator leases the service to service provider under their brand – and them having final end-user relationship ?
