My comments on Issues for consultations are as follows:-

- 1. Yes, TRAI should intervene in the validity period and stop consumer exploitation from TSP's arbitrary decisions.
- 2. Yes TSP's should be mandated and not merely advised. Because when TSP's are advised they waste time by appealing to DoT, Courts, COAI etc.
- 3. TSP's should be mandated by a tariff that should be renewed only on the same date of each month and giving an option of separate tariff of 28/29/30/31 days will again create confusion.
- 4. Yes on the lines tariff that should be renewed only on the same date of each month, the other periods viz., quarterly, half-yearly and yearly prepaid tariff offerings should be mandated.
- 5. As millennials are Studying From Home (SFH) as well as Working From Home (WFH), the TSP's should also be mandated to **introduce Truly Unlimited Data Tariff/Plans without FUP**. Because studying 5-6 Hrs daily or 8 Hrs of working daily consumes lots of data and there are no Truly Unlimited Data plans from any TSP. This problem is faced mostly in **Rural Areas** as they are not feasible for Broadband Services like Urban Areas.
