**Subject: Consultation paper on review of IUC**

Sir,

When IUC is costing 50% of call cost for consumers and its removal will result in major reduction in call charges, then why should IUC be continued beyond 1<sup>st</sup> January 2020?

IUC is a regulator imposed handicap whose original goal of compensation of cost is irrelevant now because 4G technology, in use for more than ten years now, does not entail any cost. In such a situation, there is no case for continuation of IUC as it will only result in inflated bills for the telecom customers.

We urge TRAI to first protect the interests of consumers and ensure that unnecessary extra costs are not imposed on customers in order to provide relief to companies who do not want to upgrade their technology.
