This is regarding to TRAI's plan to review Interconnection Usage Charge (IUC) regime in telecom sector. Earlier, TRAI had come out with a consultation paper on IUC and recently it had invitedconsumers and industry leaders' opinion/insights on if the Bill and Keep (BAK) regime should be deferred from the date (1 January 2020) as set earlier.

We respectfully request that the already-belated evolution to BAK by 01.01.2020 was already prescribed and it would be incorrect and unfair to revise that decision now.
