## **Telecom Regulatory Authority of India**

Information to subscribers of M/s Videocon Telecommunications Limited regarding extension of validity of Unique Porting Codes (UPC) upto 20<sup>th</sup> July 2016 in Bihar, Haryana, Gujarat, Madhya Pradesh, UP (East) and UP (West) licensed service areas and opportunity to port out their mobile numbers using Mobile Number Portability facility till 20<sup>th</sup> July 2016.

New Delhi, 23<sup>rd</sup> June, 2016 –M/s Videocon Telecommunication Limited (M/s VTL) had informed TRAI that in pursuance of the Spectrum Trading Guidelines, M/s VTL had entered into an agreement with M/s Bharti Airtel Limited to trade the right to use the entire 1800 MHz spectrum allotted to it by the licensor in Bihar, Haryana, Gujarat, Madhya Pradesh, UP(East) and UP(West) licensed service areas (LSAs). M/s VTL has already discontinued its commercial services with effect from midnight of 11<sup>th</sup> May, 2016 and had requested the subscribers in these LSAs to port out to other service providers of their choice using mobile number portability.

- 2. In order to ensure that the subscribers of M/s VTL continue to have uninterrupted mobile services after closing of its services in the above 6 licensed service areas, TRAI had directed M/s VTL on 25<sup>th</sup> April 2016 to generate Unique Porting Codes (UPCs) for all its existing subscribers before 11<sup>th</sup> May 2016, so that its subscribers could port out their mobile numbers to service provider of their choice till 31<sup>st</sup> May, 2016.
- 3. M/s VTL has further requested TRAI that as many of its subscribers in Bihar, Haryana, Gujarat, Madhya Pradesh, UP(East) and UP(West) licensed service areas have still not been able to port out their numbers by 31<sup>st</sup> May, 2016, validity of the UPCs be extended further for a period of 30 days.
- 4. Through this press release, TRAI informs all subscribers of M/s VTL in Bihar, Haryana, Gujarat, Madhya Pradesh, UP(East) and UP(West) licensed service areas,



who have still not availed MNP facility to port their mobile numbers, can do so, using the UPC codes generated by M/s VTL that expired on 31<sup>st</sup> May, 2016, valid till 23:59:59 hours of 20<sup>th</sup> July 2016.
